PUBLIC WORKS

Project update: The new roundabout at County Road 50 and Hamburg Avenue will have the pavement striped later this week and is planned to be open to traffic on Monday.

Streets, Fleets, Constructions Services and Utilities

- Street crews are actively patching around manholes in the street after the Utility Division has repaired the manholes.
- Streets staff are spray patching high iron areas in preparation for plow season.
- Street staff are working on storm sewer repairs and inspections.
- Streets and Utility staff worked together this week to vactor out a clogged storm sewer system.
- Utility staff are assisting Utility Billing with resident questions about their bills. Most of the cases are issues related to irrigation. We can show them a chart of their hourly usage, and they didn't realize the amount of water they were using for irrigation. The average home's irrigation system uses about 500 to 600 gallons per hour, and most irrigation cycles last 2 to 3 hours.
- Utility staff are continuing to clean sanitary sewer trouble spots, as well as some storm sewer cleaning as needed.

PARKS AND RECREATION

Park Administration and Maintenance

- The first draft of the Winter-Spring brochure has been reviewed by staff, and online registration opens on October 9.
- The Parks System Master Planning process is officially underway. Staff, along with the consultant, hosted a community engagement event this past weekend at the Lakeville Area Art Festival.
- Exterior doors at the Heritage Center have successfully been switched over to Proxess.

Recreation and Heritage Center

- Staff is gathering player numbers from youth sports associations and working on closing out the 2025 season.
- Sand Volleyball Leagues at Antlers Park wrapped up in mid-September. Congratulations to the following teams:

Lakeville Police Department Update

Weekly Review

Please note, the Weekly Review does not include all calls to which the Lakeville Police Department responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers responded to a shoplifting incident at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue of some Minnesota Vikings gear. The suspect was identified and was mailed a citation for the offense.
- Officers completed a report of tools stolen from a vehicle at 7XXX 215th Street West that were valued around \$3,000. Patrol is following up to review surveillance.
- Another theft report was completed at 18XXX Greenstone Way where roughly two hundred items were taken from the victims porch. The victim advised they were cleaning out their residence and selling items through Facebook Marketplace. A suspect showed up with a rental vehicle and took everything. Patrol is following up.
- Multiple officers responded to a structure fire at 18XXX Key West Court. Upon arrival, officers evacuated all connected residences. The homeowner said a battery in the kitchen was sparking and popping and they attempted to extinguish the flames with water but was unsuccessful. The Lakeville Fire Department responded and extinguished the flames.
- A two-vehicle injury accident occurred at Dodd Boulevard and 190th Street where one vehicle rolled. The at-fault driver was traveling northbound on Dodd Boulevard and attempted to turn left on 190th failing to yield to southbound traffic. The at-fault driver was mailed a citation.
- Officers located a vehicle where the registered owner showed a hit for a misdemeanor warrant. The passenger was identified as the owner with the warrant and was subsequently arrested and released on bail.
- Multiple officers responded to a jackknifed tractor trailer on 215th Street and Juniper Way. The driver was confused with construction and mistakenly attempted a u-turn which unfortunately gridlocked traffic. The driver was cited for various violations
- A two-vehicle crash occurred at 185th Street and Kenrick Avenue where one vehicle believed the light turned green to go westbound on 185th from northbound Kenrick but realized when he hit the car in front of him that it wasn't green. A traffic accident report was completed.
- Officers completed a theft report from a victim at 21XXX Heron Way where his storage unit was broken into and multiple items were missing along with his set of gold clubs that were valued at \$5,000. Detectives are investigating the case.
